

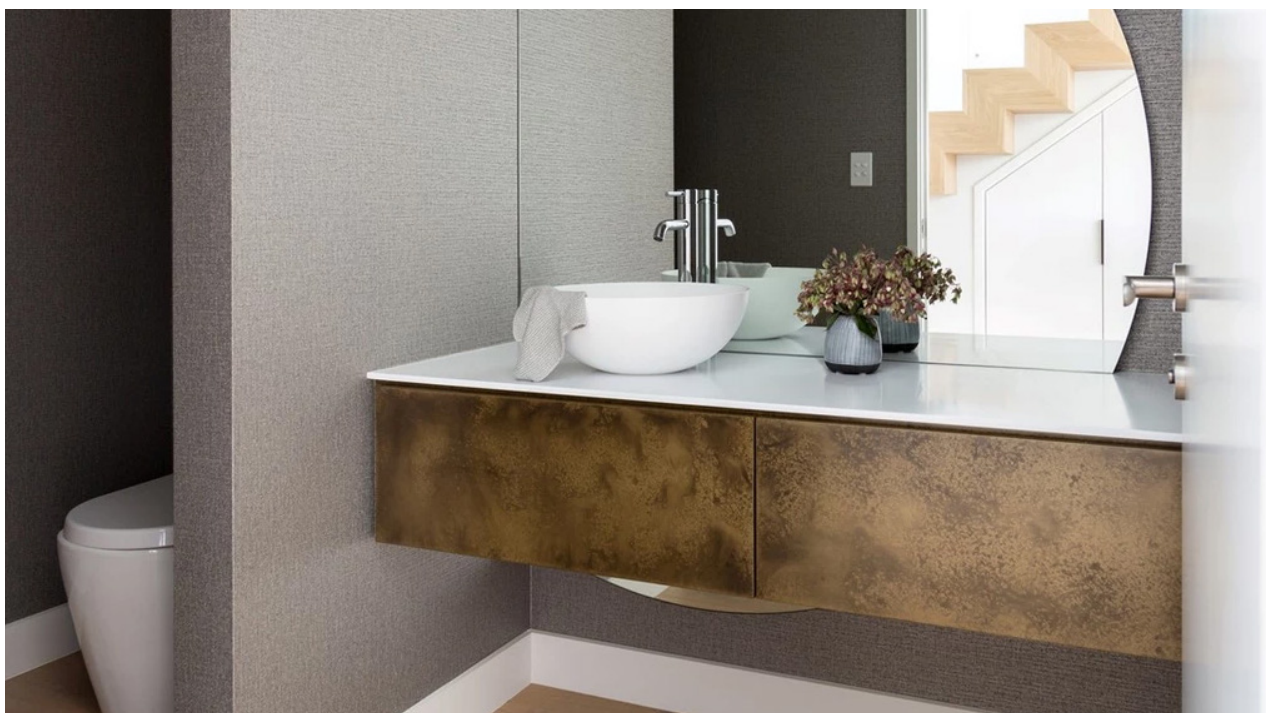

DESCRIPTION

Metalier coatings can be used in wet areas such as bathrooms. Here Water-aged Brass is applied effectively to drawer fronts in a powder room. Water-aged finishes can be created with most finishes provided they can be applied horizontally. After a light sanding and water-aging, the finish is sealed with a semi-gloss clear coat.

DESCRIPTION

Water-aged Bronze was used to create these oversized doors for a bathroom. The doors, once sanded, were laid down together so that they could have patina applied to them all at the same time. The patinating of adjoining panels must be done at the same time. This is because ambient temperatures and humidity affect how and how quickly a patina reacts. This is metal as art. These doors were sealed with a semi-gloss clear coat.

DESCRIPTION

These mirror frames were coated with Metalier in Classic Gold. They were hand-finished to a high level and then clear coated with a gloss sheen. Hand sanding with very small tools was required because of the intricate design of the frame.
